- ❑ Submit Official Transcript demonstrating 3.0 GPA or better (unweighted)
- ❑ Letter of recommendation from Science OR Math teacher
- ❑ Letter of recommendation from school principal
- ❑ Student Essay – explaining why you should be given this opportunity to attend conference

Additionally the student will be responsible for securing a US passport on their own.
